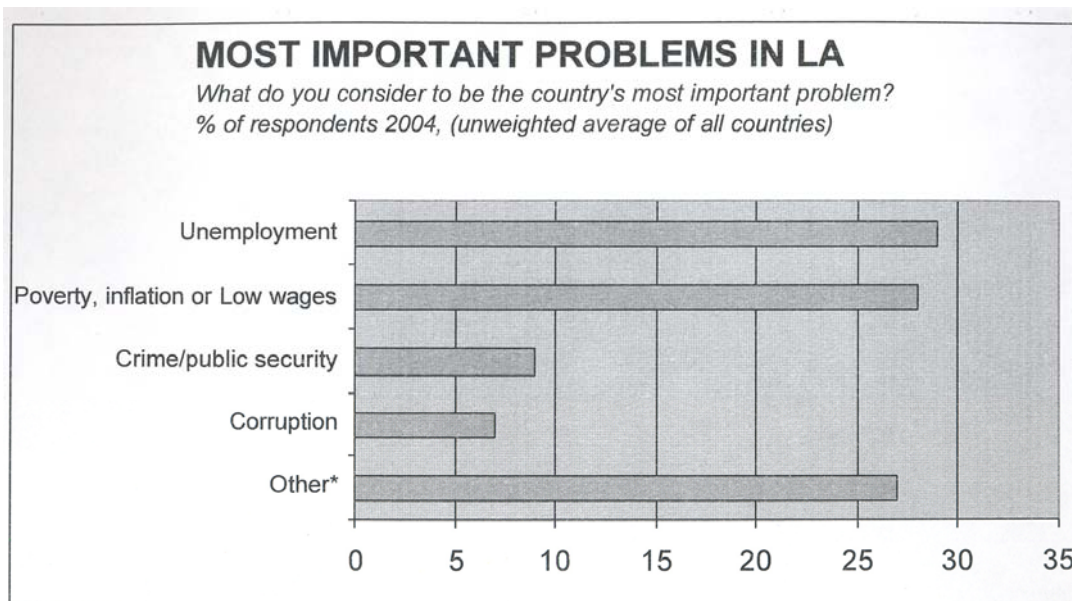

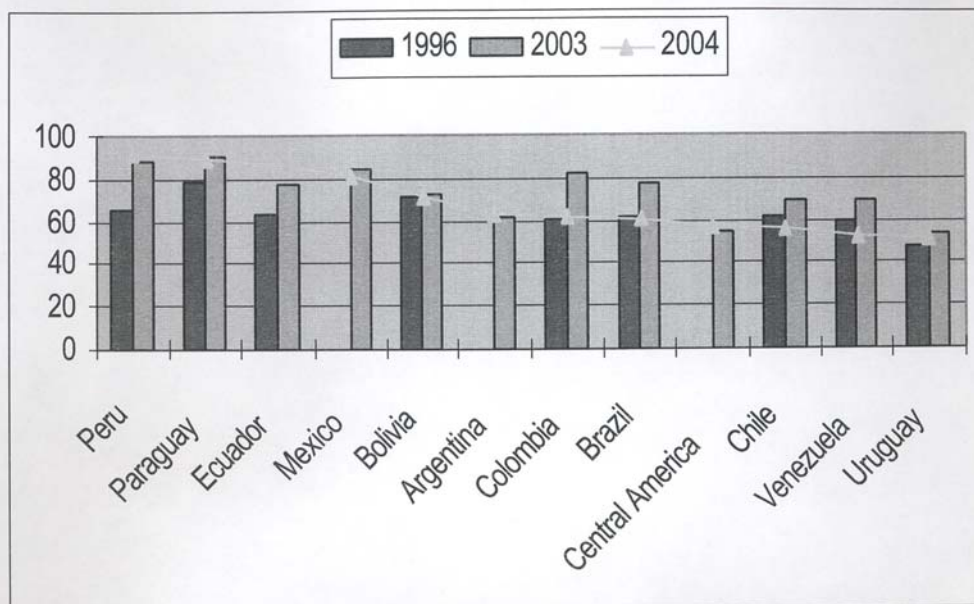

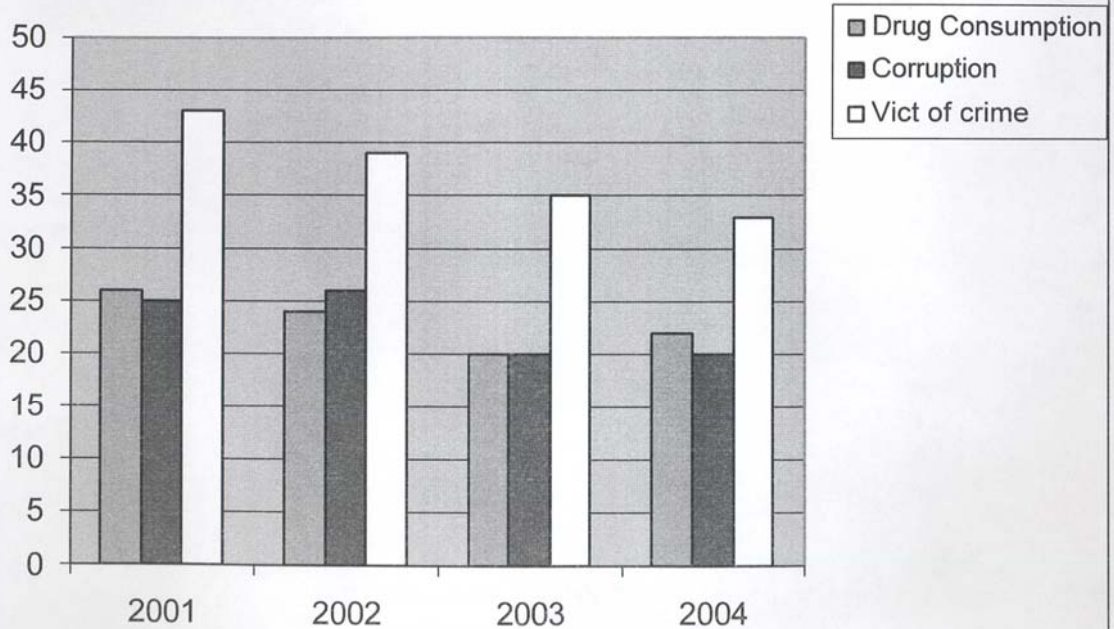
*How satisfied are you with the way democracy works in your country?

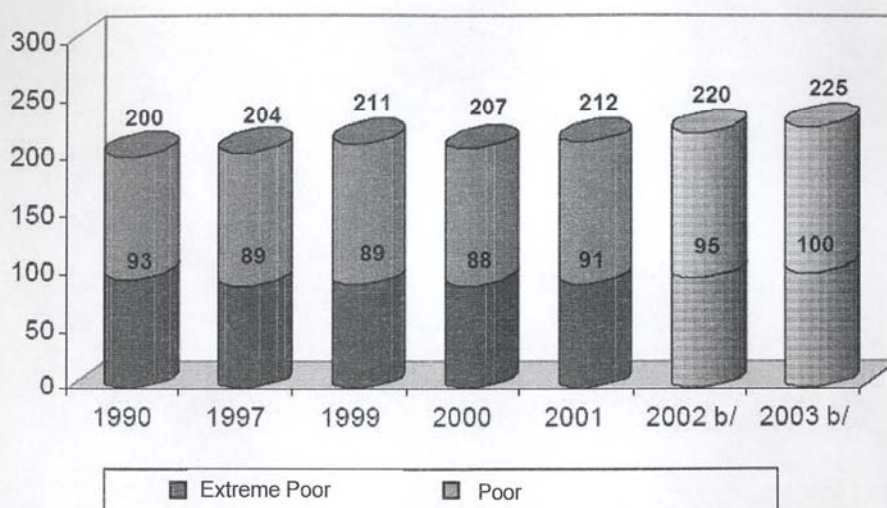
Victim

% responding "yes" (unweighted average of all countries)



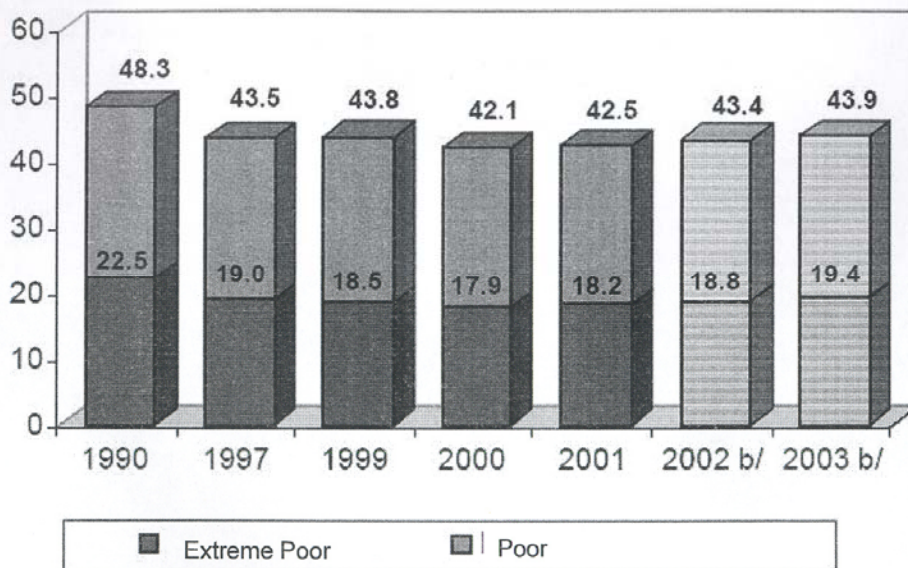

EVOLUTION OF POVERTY IN LA (MILLION OF PERSONS)



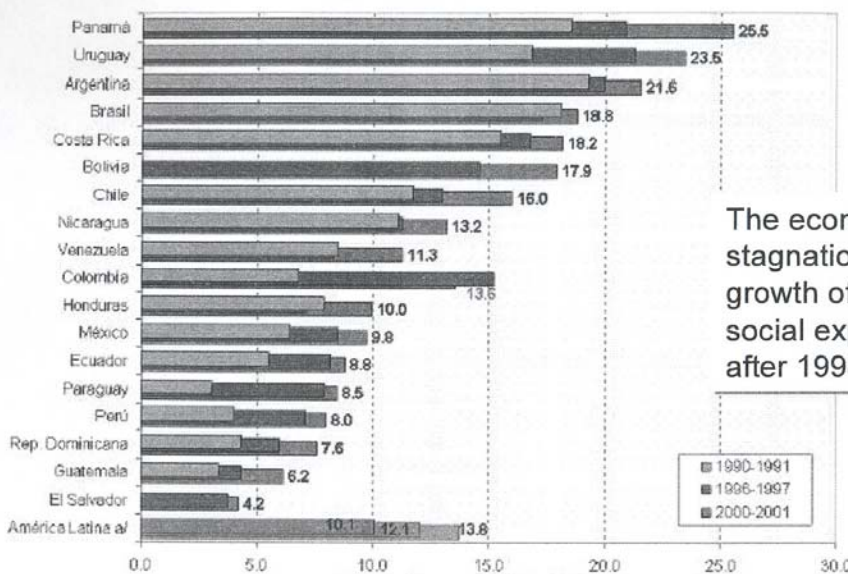
