Strategy	Tactics and Groups that Employ Them	
Accommodation	<p>The Economic Approach: Occupational queuing and use of special niches. Groups using: Scots, Welsh, Germans, Scandinavians, Dutch, Japanese, Chinese, Koreans, blacks (Booker T. Washington followers).</p>	<p>The Political Approach: Machine Politics and coalitions, electoral-generated gains. Groups using: Irish, Italians, Greeks, Jews, Slavs, Women (e.g. NOW).</p>
Separatism	<p>Physical Separatism: Moving to isolated areas. Groups using: Chinese, Amish, Mennonites, Mormons, Native Americans, blacks (Marcus Garvey followers).</p>	<p>Psychological Separatism: Building shell around members. Groups using: Black Muslims, Hasidic Jews, millennial religious groups.</p>
Radicalism	<p>Old-Style Radicalism: Ideological "isms." Groups using: Socialism: Jews, Poles, Germans, Slavs, Russians, radical agrarianism, Utopian movements.</p>	<p>New-Style Radicalism Nonviolent to violent protest actions. Groups using: SCLC, SNCC, CORE, Black Panthers, SEA, AIM, UFW of Cesar Chavez.</p>
